

Hua Hin Sightseeing and Temples tour

Wat Huay Mongkol (Big Buddha Temple)



Wat Huay Mongkol Temple is located about 10km west of Hua Hin. Thousands of Thai Buddhist pilgrims come to visit Wat Huay Mongkol Temple every weekend to pay homage to the largest Buddha image of Luang Phor Tuad in Thailand, commissioned by Queen Sirikit of Thailand.

Wat Huay Mongkol was home to the monk who was famed for his miracles. Not only is Wat Huay Mongkol regarded as a holy place but it has also become a recreational area for visitors.

Hua Hin Railway Station

The Hua Hin railway station is one of oldest railway station in Thailand. Its most striking feature is the unique Royal Waiting Room in Thai architectural style.

The Royal Waiting Room was built in the reign of King Rama VI in order to welcome the King and his entourage. Built in the same architectural style as Maruekkhathaiyawan Palace, it stands adjacent to the station and is a favourite spot for taking pictures for both Thai and foreign tourists.

The name of Plearn Wan derives from Play + Learn + Wan (previous days). It is inspired from the love and years for Hua Hin in the past. Plearn Wan is originated as a new travel destination for Hua Hin residents and visitors.
